CAMPGROUND ATTENDANT

- Campground attendants are not onsite; they will check the site and washrooms daily.

ACCOUNTABILITY

- Campers must read and follow all terms of use. Non-compliance may result in warnings, extra charges, or eviction.
- The Town is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Campers must inspect their site upon arrival and report unsafe conditions immediately.
- Sites must be kept neat and tidy, as outlined in the Town's Property Responsibility Bylaw.
- Campers must stay within the boundaries of their designated site and must not encroach, enter/walkthrough other sites.

CHECK-IN/OUT

- Check-in: 2 pm_ Check-out: 11 am

QUIET TIME & Generators

- Quiet hours are between 11:00 pm – 7:00 am.
- Generator use is limited to 2 hours at a time, outside quiet time, and must not disturb neighbours.

BOOKING

- Staying without a confirmed booking and payment is considered **trespassing** and results in eviction.
- This is **not a long-term campground**. Maximum stay is **14 days**. Extensions require pre-approval from management at their discretion.
- Stays will be reduced or cancelled by Town Staff for non-compliance with Terms of Use.

AMENITIES

- **Campsites:** 18 total (14 with 30 AMP power; 4 without power). No sewer or water hookups.
- **Water:** Located near Site 5 (group cookhouse)
- **Wi-Fi:** Free. Password provided with payment receipt.
- **Washroom/Shower:** Code provided upon payment. One shower and toilet are available daily.
- **Nearby:** Millennium Park, shops, restaurants, and trails.

The campground is adjacent to active sports fields. The Town of Diamond Valley is not liable for damage or injury caused by flying balls.



VEHICLES

- Each campsite includes **1 (one)** parking spot. Additional parking is available outside the gate.

PICNIC TABLES AND CAMPFIRES

- Each site includes a fire pit and picnic table.
- Fires must be in designated pits, monitored at all times and fully extinguished before leaving.
- Firewood is not sold on-site; bring your own or purchase locally.

DUMP STATION

- Available at Lions Club Campground (5 St SW, Diamond Valley) for a fee

Restrictions

- **ATVs, Dirt Bikes, & Drones:** not permitted inc. children's battery-operated or electronic units.
- **Firearms & Fireworks:** prohibited

SPRAY PARK AND POOL (403-933-7483)

- The spray park is free to use; it is turned on in the morning and off at night.
- [Dr. Lander Memorial Pool](#) is pay per use. Visit diamondvalley.town/pool for schedule and fees.

PETS

- Pets are welcome but must be always leashed and under control.
- Clean-up after your pet and dispose of waste in designated bins. Including spilled food.
- Owners assume full legal and financial liability for any incidents involving their pets.
- Pets shall not be left unattended inside or outside.

ALCOHOL

- Allowed at your campsite only.
- Secure your coolers and lock your units when not on-site.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

- All garbage must be bagged, sealed, and placed in designated bins. DO NOT leave out at anytime.
USED PROPANE BOTTLES, BROKEN CHAIRS, AND EQUIPMENT MUST BE TAKEN WITH YOU.

WILDLIFE

- Wildlife is present year-round. Do not approach, feed, or attract animals.
 - Clean up any food spills on your site, do not put garbage in fire pits.
 - All food should be stored inside a vehicle or in tamper proof containers. Not in tents
- Refunds are NOT issued due to wildlife unless the Town of Diamond Valley cancels your reservation due to safety. Visit our [website](#) for more information about wildlife in the area.
