- 1. Persons participate in the Diamond Valley Parade at their own risk. The Town of Diamond Valley is not responsible for the actions of parade participants.
- 2. Marshalling will take place at the Oilfields Regional Arena. Parking will **NOT** be permitted at the arena. To avoid traffic jams and parking issues, we encourage all participants to car-pool.
- 3. All parade entries should be in place by 9:00 am.
- 4. For safety reasons, novelties and candies **MUST NOT BE THROWN** from floats. They may, however, be passed out by hand.
- 5. If sports equipment is used in the entry, please use only soft foam balls.
- 6. Persons riding in vehicles or floats must sit or be provided with and use handrails or other devices which secure them from falling.
- 7. Please leave water pistols, water balloons, super-soakers at home!
- 8. Entrants must maintain control of participants, vehicles, and animals at all times. All pets must be leashed or caged.
- 9. Parade participants must follow the direction of parade personnel in the assembly area and/or along the route regarding placement, pace, etc.
- 10. Appropriate behavior and float decorations are expected due to the family nature of this event.
- 11. **NO** consumption of alcoholic beverages or possession of alcoholic containers by participants during the parade. Those failing to comply will be subject to arrest.
