MAYOR'S MESSAGE

As the snowflakes start to fall and we welcome the coziest season of the year, we're looking forward to the holiday events and festivities ahead we make our way into the holiday season.

Our local heroes at Diamond Valley Fire & Rescue are back with their annual [Firefighter Food Drive](#) this fall. Fire department members will be going door to door in the Turner Valley community on Monday, November 13, and Black Diamond community on Tuesday, November 14, from 5:30 - 9:30 pm each night. Please consider donating non-perishable food and household items to the [Oilfields Food Bank](#) which will be given to local families in need this winter. Have the donations ready by the door, or set a bag out on the front porch if you plan to not be home that evening.

The rates for water and wastewater services are under review by Council in order to equalize the rates between the two communities and to move toward full cost recovery for these services. These changes will allow us to maintain a high level of service delivery and plan for future infrastructure investment. The Town will be hosting an open house on Monday, November 27 where residents can find out more and ask questions about the proposed changes. Council has released it's [Strategic Plan](#) that sets the vision and priorities for staff and Council; guidelines that help with decision making and set goals for success. We are currently recruiting a Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to lead administration and Council toward achieving these strategic objectives. The public works department is reminding residents to remove any driveway ramps or basketball nets from the street to allow for efficient and safe snow removal. Also, due to blockages caused by flushable wipes, there have been a quite a few costly pump repairs needed in the sewage system - remember there is NO SUCH THING AS A FLUSHABLE WIPE! Please do not flush anything but TP, folks.

Municipal enforcement staff has asked us to remind residents that snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks within 48 hours of snowfall, and that it is an offence to throw snow onto the streets. Remember to pile your snow on your own lawns and shrubs (they love it!). These both carry a \$250 penalty in accordance with the Property Responsibility Bylaw, and [concerns can be reported on our website](#).

Local businesses are gearing up to open their doors and light up the night on Saturday, December 2, from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm for the annual [Light Up Diamond Valley](#) festivities. Join your friends and neighbours for a wander through the beautifully lit businesses on Centre Avenue and Government Road and take a horse drawn hay wagon ride through the glittering streets. Don't forget to stop in to visit Santa at FUEL, located in the Sheep River Centre on the corner of Centre Avenue and 1st Street SW.
