This course is a lasting example of what can be achieved through community collaboration.

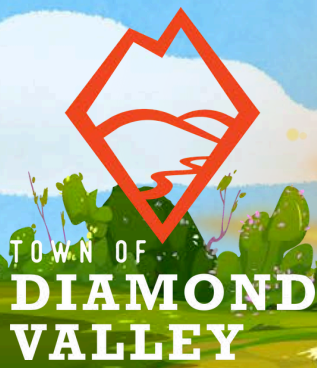
